Top Three Reasons Students Selected PRCC


- Convenient location
- Good reputation
- Selection of course offerings

Personal Goals

- 97% established personal goals for their education
- 96% of those students met some or all of their goals at PRCC

Technology

- 83% said preparation for a technical world was important
- 77% were satisfied with the level of technical preparation received



Employment while attending PRCC

- 65% of students were employed while attending PRCC
- 40% worked between 16 and 39 hours per week
- 16% worked 40 hours or more per week

Diversity & Belonging

- 73% were satisfied or very satisfied with their opportunities to interact with a diverse student body at PRCC
- 76% felt a sense of belonging at PRCC
- 81% would choose to attend PRCC again if they were starting over today.

Respondent Demographics

- 71% Age 25 or under (traditional students)
- 63% Female/37% Male
- 27% Black/70% White/3% Other


