POPLARVILLE - Pearl River County is well positioned for economic development.

That was the message from Dr. Shannon Campbell at the Nov. 3 Lunch and Learn cosponsored by Pearl River Community College, the Poplarville Area Chamber of Commerce and BankPlus.
