


Self-Registering Your Network Devices

This document will guide you in registering your network devices, such as a gaming consoles, media streaming devices, or other devices that do not support the authentication method used on the “PRCC” wireless network. After you register your devices, you will connect those devices to the “PRCC-Devices” wireless network. **All phones, tablets and computers** should continue to use the “PRCC” wireless network.


1. On your computer or phone, navigate to <http://www.prcc.edu/devices>
2. Enter your RiverGuide credentials to log in.

3. Once you are logged in, you can register up to 5 devices. To register your first device, click “Add”.
4. Fill out the form with the device name, Device ID (MAC address), and if desired, a description. Click Submit.
