

PEARL RIVER CELEBRATES HISTORIC SPRING ENROLLMENT AND A DECADE OF OUTPACING THE STATE AVERAGE IN GROWTH

New all-time highs for enrollment and credit hours have Pearl River Community College celebrating its continued progress toward making higher education affordable, accessible, and efficient.

The 10th Day Enrollment Report published by the Mississippi Community College Board arrived with news of the record-setting enrollment of 5,061 students for the spring semester. This marks the first time in the institution's history that spring enrollment topped 5,000 students. There has been a 17.75% growth in enrollment from 2018 to 2024 while the state average saw a drop of 12.3%. Pearl River is the only community college in the state to experience a headcount gain in that period.



The Wildcats picked up 10 runs on 10 hits and shut out the Aggies from the fourth inning on to secure a 10-3 win and a series victory.








CROWNING ACHIEVEMENT: PRCC'S EMMA WATTS TAKES MISS DIXIE NATIONAL TITLE


