



2024/2025 PRCC Digital Course Materials Fee List

If your course is using an eBook or course content module, it is using a digital course materials package which is integrated into your Canvas Course Shell on **DAY ONE** of your class. This contains an eBook and any additional software required by the instructor for your course. If an eBook/course material are required for your course, a fee will automatically be added to your student bill so you do not have to pay for this up front. These fees are attached to the course and are non-refundable once you pass the add/drop date of the course. PRCC uses an equitable access program for all digital course materials which allows the institution to keep your overall textbook costs down. All courses using this model are charged a flat fee of \$30 per credit hour, so your average class will only cost you \$90 for your eBook, course content module (such as MindTap, MyLab, Connect, etc.) and any additional resources. In the past textbooks were costing students over \$1,000 per semester! This model has allowed us to nearly cut that cost in half.

Where to find my eBook and course materials?

If your course is using an eBook, you will find these materials located under the RedShelf eReader tab inside Canvas on day one of your class **OR** if using Cengage Unlimited these resources will be identified by your instructor in a specific module inside your Canvas Course Shell.

Can I purchase a print book with my eBook?

We strongly encourage all students to take advantage of the eBook as it can be accessed on all of your devices including your cell phone, tablets, computers, and TVs as long as you have WIFI/internet available! Our industry partners have told us that they want students to learn how to use digital materials as many businesses and industries have moved to online manuals.

If you find yourself having trouble with the eBook and would like to purchase a loose-leaf, the Print on Demand option is found inside the RedShelf eReader tab for courses who provide this option, but an additional fee is required to purchase a loose-leaf. These loose-leaf copies are mailed directly to your home and are not affiliated with the PRCC Bookstore.

Those courses who use a Cengage publisher have the option to order a rental textbook through Cengage Unlimited. The hardcopy textbook rental option is located in the Cengage link in your Canvas Course Shell module.
