| Threshold of Acceptability | Student job placement is defined as students placed or retained in employment or placed in military service or apprenticeship programs in the second quarter following the program year in which they left postsecondary education. Pearl River Community College uses the goal set by the Carl Perkins reporting standard of 75% overall job placement for program-completing students. | | |
