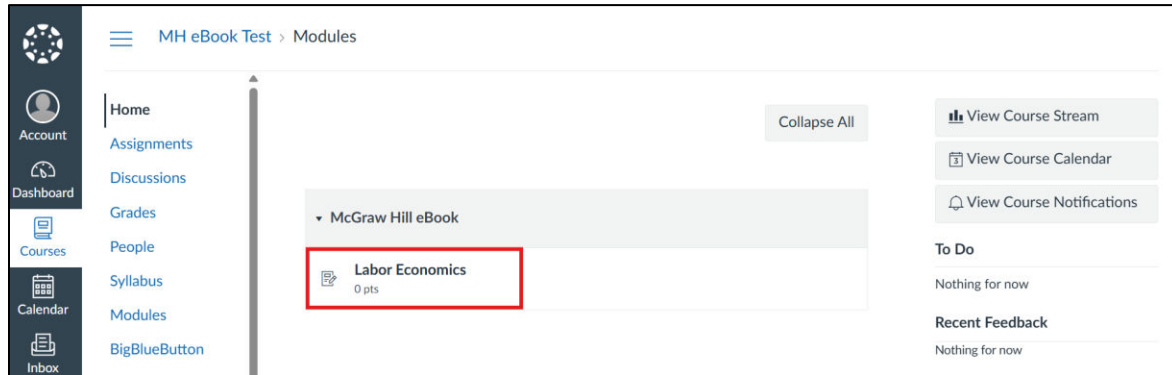

# McGraw Hill eBook Student Set-up

## Access the McGraw Hill eBook

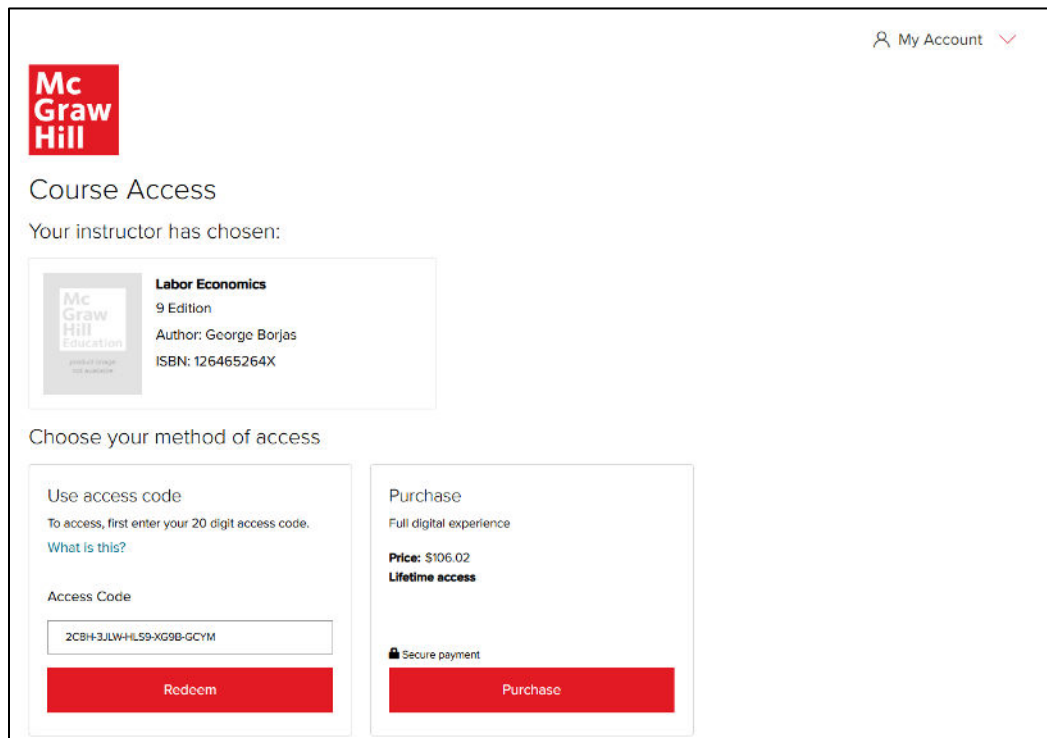
**STEP 1:** Select the McGraw Hill eBook link from your Canvas assignments list.




If you are part of an Inclusive Access\* program (\*also known as First Day access or something similar, where students are provided with access to course materials on or before the first day of class), **skip to STEP 4.**

**STEP 2:** If you are not part of an Inclusive Access\* program, you will have two access options:

1. **Use Access Code:** Enter a McGraw Hill access code and click **Redeem.**
2. **Purchase:** Select **Purchase** to use a credit card or PayPal.



**STEP 3:** After selecting an option, review the course information and access length and select **Confirm**. (Note: This will automatically link your Canvas account with the McGraw Hill eBook, so there is no need to enter any additional student information.)
